The booking fee is due on signing this agreement with the balance of the amount agreed due 14 days before the day of the wedding. The bride and groom agree to provide a hot meal for the photographer(s) where the length of attendance exceeds five hours. "Any photographers employed by Murray Clarke" covers either second photographers or photographers employed by Murray Clarke. The primary photographer who will be capturing your wedding on the day is Murray Clarke unless otherwise agreed.

CONFIRMATION: A signed "CONTRACT FOR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY SERVICES" and payment of the booking fee are necessary to confirm the stated wedding services from Murray Clarke and any photographers employed by Murray Clarke.

PRE-WEDDING CONSULTATION: This normally happens at the time of booking. The bride and groom will outline broadly what is required and Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography will advise on planning, logistics and timings where needed. Further consultations will take place prior to the wedding day detailing the specific requirements of the bride and groom.

COOPERATION: The bride and groom and Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography consent to happily cooperate and communicate with each other to achieve the best possible result within the understanding of this contract. I recommend that a helper (usually the best man) will point out key individuals to be photographed. Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography may also require the assistance of the best man in organising family groups. The bride and groom also agree to give Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography sufficient warning of key events at the wedding to give time to prepare e.g. bouquet throwing, cutting the cake, speeches etc.

Please note that not all guests at the wedding like having their photo taken. In such cases Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography will use discretion but cannot be held responsible for a lack of photos of these people.

THE SCHEDULE: The shooting schedule, style of working and experience are designed to achieve a great set of wedding photos for the bride and groom, accomplished with good humour and enjoyed by all concerned. Both the bride and groom and Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography therefore agree that punctuality and cheerful cooperation are essential to producing outstanding photographic results. In cases where the wedding does not run on time (for example, extreme lateness by the bride arriving to the church) a normal set of photos cannot be guaranteed however the photographer will do the absolute best to compensate.

PAPARAZZI WEDDING GUESTS: All your guests will have digital cameras and many want to photograph the bride and groom. In the spirit of cheerful cooperation the bride and groom agree to give Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography precedence over your guests in order to take the photographs required for the wedding services described above. Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography cannot be held liable for a lack of wedding photos if guests taking their own photos of the bride and groom have continually interrupted the work of the photographer.

HOUSE RULES: Note that Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography may sometimes be limited by rules imposed by registrars, ministers and venue management as to what can and cannot be done. For example some ministers insist that no flash photography is allowed, and others will insist that photographers shoot from a specific location. In such circumstances the bride and groom agree to accept the technical limitations that may be imposed on the equipment used. I advise the bride and groom to make themselves aware of the rules of the venue concerned and if necessary negotiate with the personnel concerned.

COPYRIGHT LAW: English Copyright Law states that the copyright of photographs remains with Murray Clarke. Murray Clarke grants the bride and groom permission to make copies of the images under the following conditions: The images taken by Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography are for personal use by the bride and groom and their friends and relatives. Selling, publication or any commercial use of the photographs is not allowed without prior written permission from Murray Clarke.

PROMOTIONAL USAGE: The bride and groom grant Murray Clarke consent to use the photographs for editorial and advertising purposes. The bride and groom hereby release Murray Clarke and his legal representatives from all liability and claims in connection with the images.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY: If Murray Clarke and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography become too ill or injured and cannot supply the wedding services specified above Murray Clarke will try to book a replacement wedding photographer. If a replacement photographer cannot be found then liability is limited to a refund of any payments received.

Murray Clarke has working methods in place to prevent the loss or damage of your images. However, there is the unlikely possibility that images may be lost, stolen or destroyed for reasons beyond Murray Clarke's and/or photographers employed by Murray Clarke Photography's control. In these circumstances liability is limited to the return of fees paid for the service or part thereof according to the percentage of images supplied.

BOOKING FEE/CANCELLATION: In the event of the bride and groom cancelling the wedding for whatever reason the booking fee is non-refundable and will be considered as liquidated damages to Murray Clarke. Cancellation less than 12 weeks prior to the date of the wedding will result in a 50% fee of the remaining balance. The client(s) are hereby advised to take out an appropriate insurance policy to cover any expenses incurred in the event of cancellation.

We have understood the contents of this contract and agree to the terms therein.
